For the past three years, <u>En avant math!</u> has helped identify solutions to ensure the development of a highly qualified workforce in applied mathematics and to promote a better match between the skills of individuals and the needs of the labour market, particularly in the science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) sectors.

For the past ten years, the CIRANO Barometer on Risk Perception in Quebec has been drawing an evocative portrait of Quebecers' priorities based on the results of surveys developed by CIRANO and administered to a sample of 1000 respondents representative of the Quebec population. In each edition of the CIRANO Barometer, respondents are asked to identify their top two personal and collective concerns from a list of ten major issues. In this year's edition, for the first time since the first survey, economic and financial issues have taken the lead among Quebecers' personal concerns, overtaking issues related to the health system.

CEO Seminar: Charles Brindamour, Chief Executive Officer - Intact Financial Corporation


